

EXERCISE MARITIME RAIDER 09

- More than 580 members from 37 Canadian Brigade Group (CBG), elements of Land Force Atlantic Area, 35 Field Ambulance, 72 Communications Group and participants of the U.S. Army are participating in Exercise Maritime Raider 09, from Feb. 27 to March 8 at Fort Pickett, Virginia
- The exercise represents the culmination of collective training for the 08/09 training year
- In addition to the normal trade oriented training conducted by the individual units of the Brigade throughout the year, non-commissioned members and officers will undertake specific training designed to mesh their individual trade skills into a combat team leadership cadre
- 37 CBG is comprised of some 1,500 members of which, approximately 70 are members of the Regular Force
- The Brigade headquarters is located in Moncton, New Brunswick. and has ten units under its command
- These units are located in 15 communities throughout New Brunswick and Newfoundland and Labrador
