from the 173rd Airborne Brigade Combat Team (ABCT) discovered a sizeable cache in Kuz Jangjay, Sayed Abad District, Wardak Province, Afghanistan, April 26, 2010. The Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF) worked with the 173rd ABCT to exploit a report of a cache near the Kuz Jangjay village. ANSF regularly joins the 173rd Airborne Brigade Combat Team for combined operations in the Sayed Abad District. The cache depicted consisted of 12 AK-47s, 4 bolt-action rifles, 1 double-barreled shotgun, 1 RPG launcher, 6 loaded AK magazines, 3 loaded M16 magazines, 2 empty AK magazines, 206 live 7.62 mm rounds, 133 live rifle rounds, 1 bullet proof vest, 4 magazines, 1 RPG assault rack, 200 lbs of Home-made Explosives, 12 RPGs, 5 grenades, 9 boosters, 100 lbs of wire, trigger switches, and home-made blasting caps.
