planned projects at Kaneohe Bay and the effect of the base realignment on the air station. For the past 18 months the base
has been fighting for its existence, has been fighting for its existence,
Col. Crawford explained. Because of Base Closure and Realignment Committee's recommendations, the base is going to have significant
growth through 1996. growth through 1996.
realign ment recommendations and allowed to become law, Naval Air Station Barbers Point will close and Kaneohe Bay will receive
many of Barbers Point's assets. Although there will be some Marine assets leaving the base,
Kaneohe will grow significantly. "The base is going to have significant growth - and it all

planning on having the Navy planning on having the Navy,

Guard here," Col. Crawford explained. "Most of the growth

University of Iowa. A plane crash claimed the ife of the reigning NASCAR champion Alan Kuwicki and a helicopter crash took NASCAR driver Davey Allison just three weeks ago. The Boston Celtic star Reggie Lewis died during Thasketball practice.

Lewis, while shooting basketa at the Caltics Lewis, while shooting baskets at the Caltics

him to be in' "complete cardiac arreat." He had
no pulse and was revived with CPR but died no pules and was revived with CPR but died

A toam of cardiologists ozaminod Lewis on
May 2 and concluded that Lewis buffered from
a heart disease called cardiomyopathy. The a heart disease callod cardiomyopathy. The
disease is caused by the abnormal thickening of the muscles between the chambers in the heart. This causes an irregular heartbeat and death. This was a dificult prognonis for the 27 -year-
old star. The fact of the matter wai that his carser was over. Lowis was considered by many who know him as, "eppecial, sincore, honest, hind
caring and humble." Follow players regarded caring and humble. Fellow players regarded
him as a role model and leader by example.

Celtics president Red Auerbach said, "his
infoctious smile and joyous love of basketball infectious smile and joyous,
were always evident to us."
Many families in the Boaton and reas had received help from Lewis in his work with underpriveledged families as well as his with un
active

Upon receiving the prognosis, he and Boston Ceam of doctors gave a much less serious pecond of neurocardiogenic a much opess, which is a fainting condition. The solution is; take some medication and slowly progresi back to a full-playing level.
If Lowis had listened to the firnt team of doctors he would probably still be alive, nfortunately he opted for the second team with
