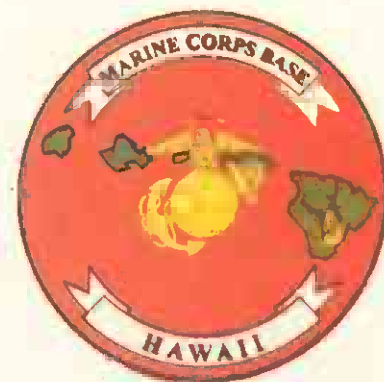

Weather damage in thousands

Hangar 103 here endured roof damage during recent heavy storms resulting in repair costs of over \$150,000.

A storm with substantial southerly winds swept through the bay late December with nothing to stop it but Hangar 103's large profile. The wind lifted a gutter, peeling it up and with a domino-effect, continued pulling up roofing material.

"That's a very large gutter to take the rain off that large roof and it has a higher likelihood of being taken by the wind. They're normally built for that, but the wind can find a weak point and once it does, it continues to rip at the roof," explained Capt. Joel B. Baker, facilities maintenance officer.



Emergency repairs, to include the replacement of two skylights, were completed Jan. 10 and 11.

In addition, puncture holes were created as pieces of roofing material fell onto portions of the roof left intact. Two skylights, measuring 6 by 6 feet also had to be replaced. Work began Jan. 10 with two days of

emergency repairs.

"Because of the magnitude of this project, the initial goal was to have the roof sealed so no more water leaked in to damage office spaces," Baker explained. Though it did not delay the mission,

water leaking into office spaces hindered the daily work of Marine Heavy Helicopter Squadron 366.

"We moved everything we could to the center line and worked out of there," explained Capt. Ed J. Rodgers, ground training officer. "Working conditions were difficult and it increased the workload because about a quarter of every day was spent getting around water damage to the offices and having no electricity."

Problems getting insulation material slowed the project only slightly.

"It's actually happening fairly quickly considering the magnitude of project," Baker stressed.

Additional insulation material has arrived and work is presently underway with the contract scheduled to be completed Wednesday.

Guerrero family says punishment not over

One day after the last of four Marines was sentenced in conjunction with the murder of Lance Cpl. Juan R. Guerrero, the victim's family came forth Wednesday, here, for the first time since his death.

Lance Corporals Michael A. Pereira, 22, Darryle A. Antle, 22 and Alejandro Soto, 23, received life sentences in Ft. Leavenworth Discipline Barracks while Lance Cpl. William J. Baer, 20, was given 25 years imprisonment. But Guerrero's family members said their punishment is far from over.

"My brother was killed like an animal," said Adriana Guerrero-Pestonji, Guerrero's sister. "And even animals have rights like everyone else. He was a good Marine and he had a bright future. Now, he will never see it."

"When these Marines are eligible for parole, my family will be there," Guerrero-Pestonji continued. "We can't let them get away with this."

More difficult than facing a lost relative was dealing with being in the same room with his murderers,

Guerrero-Pestonji said.

"To sit there and have to face and look at them is more than anyone could stand," said Guerrero-Pestonji.

"Even after what they did, they still asked for forgiveness like they had not been part of anything," said Maria T. Guerrero, the victim's mother. "Like I told them then, they will never receive forgiveness."

"They will have to deal with punishment here on Earth," the weeping mother continued. "They will regret they were ever born."

"They took away what I loved most," said Camerino V. Guerrero, the victim's father. "He was more than they were. He was worth more than they were. They should be ashamed to wear a uniform they don't deserve."

Now, as the Marines sit behind prison bars and Guerrero's body lies buried, all his family has are memories. These memories, however, don't answer their nagging questions: Why was he killed so brutally? What did he do so wrong?

"We didn't even get to say goodbye," said Guerrero-Pestonji. "We had to sit in front of a coffin which could not be opened because of what they did

Firing procedures may change for qualification

New experimental firing procedures to analyze the Marine Corps' rifle marksmanship training program in terms of cost effectiveness, manpower, training time and training resources for rifle qualification will begin at the marksmanship range here, Monday.

Four experts from Marine Corps Development and Education Command, Quantico, Va., visited the range Jan. 13-17 to brief range personnel here on proper procedures for the testing. Results will affect the way the Marine Corps' personnel qualify with the M-16A2 rifle.

The qualification testing is directed at saving time and money by allowing Marines to accept a qualifying score on the first day of the five-day qualification process, according to CWO-3 Paul E. Malsbury, officer in charge of the range.

"If we switch to this procedure, it could be implemented as early as October this

year," said Malsbury. "Not a lot has changed as far as the course goes. We've just switched a few things around."

Normally, Marines undergo five days of rifle qualification. The first day is used to for grouping, the fourth is qualification day and the fifth is a field firing day used for various firing methods such as moving targets and firing with a gas mask.

With the new program, the first day would be spent achieving a battle site zero at the 300-yard line. It is usually obtained at the 36-yard line.

The rest of the first day is spent firing the Marine Corps known distance course. If Marines receive a qualifying score on this day of fire, they may elect to keep the score.

If they elect to keep their first score, the Marines must return on the fifth day to shoot the field fire portion.

"This may also prove the way we've been doing it is the most effective way," said Malsbury. "This method may actually hinder Marines because if we continue to cut time on the range down, you will see marksmanship skills diminish and go away."

Testing is scheduled to be conducted until April 31. Units will fire during their normally scheduled increments.

Young Marines aid frozen city

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — A record snowfall hit Kansas City during the morning rush hour in late October, blanketing the city with more than twice the amount of snow recorded for that month.

The weight of more than six inches of snow snapped thousands of tree limbs, destroying decades-old trees and power lines. Thousands of people lost electrical power for days.

The snow caused millions of dollars of damage. Even two months after the storm, officials said it would take

more months of burning and shredding to clear the city of broken limbs and logs.

Small though their help may have been, large was the impact on morale when Kansas City's Young Marines detachment assisted the community with a marathon cleanup.

Sergeant Debby Foley, who handles general officer administration at the Marine Corps Reserve Support Command, doubles as the Young Marines' "executive officer," led the cleanup. A heavy truck operator, she borrowed a 5-ton truck from the 24th Marine Regiment motor

pool, briefed the "troops," and whisked away her young chargers.

The working party of seven was joined by a couple of parents and Sgt. Carl Robertson, another active duty MCRSC Marine who is an instructor for the Young Marine detachment.

The Young Marines cleaned up Fairlane Street in the "Hickman Mills" area of Kansas City.

"I just feel good about helping other people," said 13-year-old Pvt. Fallon Hopkins. The Young Marines dumped two truck loads of debris during their four-hour community service project.

The Young Marines turned into role models and brief celebrities when a photographer from the local Fox TV affiliate filmed their work. The story aired twice that day on the evening news.

The fledgling detachment of Kansas City Young Marines is planning to do more community projects with the Salvation Army, as well as other storm cleanup projects.

"They're helping change the tainted image of today's youth," said Donna Saunders, mother of one of the Young Marine volunteers.

Leatherneck editor passes on

QUANTICO, Va. — Thomas P. Bartlett, long-time managing editor of "Leatherneck," died Monday at the National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Md., after a year-long struggle with cancer. He was 63.

Known as "Mr. Leatherneck," Bartlett served on the staff of the magazine for more than 25 years after his retirement as a master sergeant in the U.S. Marine Corps in 1971.

It was as a Marine Bartlett first served with "Leatherneck" in 1964, when the Corps still authorized active duty members to serve on the staff. As a combat correspondent for the magazine, and later as press chief for the III Marine Amphibious Force in Da Nang, Vietnam, Bartlett served four tours of duty in Vietnam.

Over the years, "Leatherneck" published more than 955 of his feature articles, often filed in combat, with young Marine enlisted men and junior officers.

Born in Rhode Island, he joined the Marine Corps in 1952. He served in Korea and Vietnam, where he was awarded a Bronze Star medal. Later, he covered the Marine mission to Somalia in 1992 as a correspondent for "Leatherneck."

He is survived by the former Frances Rossi, of Woodbridge, Va., and three sons: Thomas of Jacksonville, Fla., Scott of Sterling, Va., and Christopher of Woodbridge.

Speed impacts all drivers

Signs are posted on roads for a reason

My wife used to have a nice car. "Betsy" was a survivor of more than 108,000 mishap-free miles since rolling off the assembly line sometime in late 1987. She has been across continents and oceans and never suffered even so much as a shopping cart scratch.

That all ended right before Christmas. The car wasn't even moving as she was stopped (in traffic) waiting to make a left turn. And then wham! Hit from behind by someone going too fast and not paying attention.

I had even just waxed ol' Betsy, too. I had two other cars creamed over the holidays, as well. But that's for another time...

Chances are, you've done this, too, only you haven't hit anyone.

Oh, no, you say? I'm a good driver. Oh yeah? What do you do when you pass the Mokapu Gate? I bet you hit the accelerator. I know this because I'm the guy in the big black Dodge duallie you tailgate to the gate and then floor it to get around once we pass the gate.

The only time this *doesn't* happen is when there's nobody behind me going out the gate.

In a cruel sort of way, I now love to do the speed limit on Mokapu just to see the

frustrated looks on people's faces behind me.

The problem is speed (or integrity) and isn't restricted to lance corporals with souped-up Camaros. The cars dusting me on Mokapu Boulevard have blue stickers, red stickers and green stickers. Some have no stickers at all. So the speeding problem is not one of age or rank.

I have the same problem going out the H-3 gate.

There, you'd think the yellow flashing light is the christmas tree at Darlington, not a reminder to slow down.

A lesser man might have a problem with being dusted by a Festiva, but not me.

Why is this speeding going on? I've heard the reason is that the speed limit is: a) not enforced; or b) it's too low anyway.

Since when did Marines pick and choose what rules they would follow? So what if the speed limit isn't as rigorously enforced as it is on base? Do we shirk our duties when the colonel or the gunny is away?

Do we "rate what we skate?" That's wrong and you know it. But a lot of Marines apparently think this doesn't apply to "lesser" rules.

Judging by the driving habits of a lot of

Marines, I'd say Marines have a tendency to forget they are subject to local and state laws as well as the UCMJ. Doing 45 mph on Mokapu is as wrong as robbing Navy Federal Credit Union or sleeping with your best friend's wife.

I'd like to think I have the courage to adhere to a higher standard of personal conduct and to lead by example. Sounds admirable and it's from a document we've all sworn we've read and agreed to personally — the Commandant's Statement on Core Values of United States Marines.

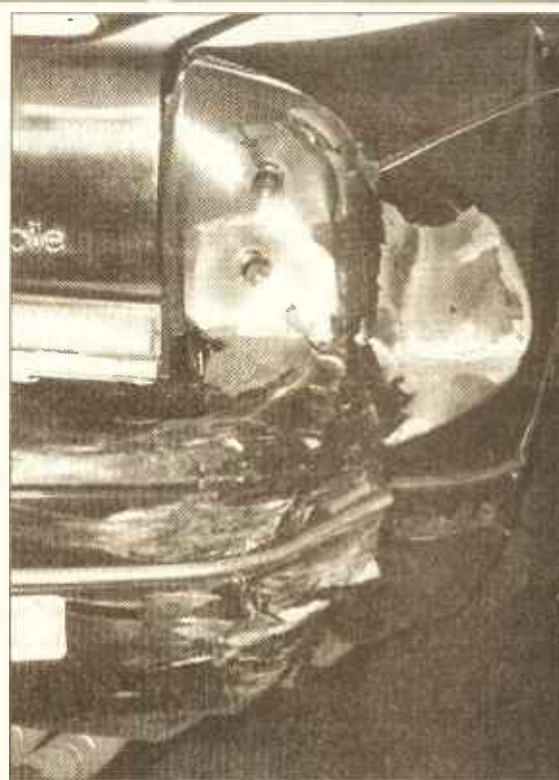

In the great scheme of the universe, whether or not you observe the speed limit on Mokapu Blvd. may not seem like an issue of cosmic importance. And perhaps it isn't, but how much importance do you place on your personal integrity?

Resolving harassment

Sexual harassment comes in many forms — some forms are virtually undetectable.

We know what sexual harassment is and that the behavior creates an intimidating and hostile work environment. But how do we stop this behavior?

Does a Marine have to immediately notify his or her chain of command and file a formal complaint, or is there a way the matter can be resolved in an informal manner? The answer depends on the situation, therefore, it is important for everyone to understand the procedures for addressing behaviors that are considered sexual harassment.

First, we need to understand that we all can make mistakes when it comes to sexual harassment. Some of these mistakes can be attributed to how we grew up (socialization), our views of the opposite gender, influence by our peers, media and other external factors, as well as our lack of understanding about how our behavior affects another individual.

With this in mind, does a sexual remark, sexual joke, or any of the verbal or nonverbal acts of sexual harassment merit a formal complaint? The answer is no. Verbal and nonverbal acts of sexual harassment can be handled by the "Informal Resolution System." The IRS stresses the individual responsibility of both the offender and the person who is offended. The system allows individuals to resolve conflict at the lowest level.

To understand the IRS, we need to place the behavior in one of three offending zones; "green," which includes behavior that is always ACCEPTABLE and not considered offensive. This could include counseling on performance or military

appearance, or normal social interaction, polite compliments or a friendly conversation.

The "yellow" zone includes behavior regarded as inappropriate by most people, including sexual comments or jokes, displaying sexual comics and other forms of verbal or nonverbal sexual harassment. The final zone is the "red" zone, which encompass behavior that is always unacceptable; asking for sexual favors in return for a good performance evaluation, making supervisory decisions because of a person's race or gender, and sending "hate" mail. The most severe forms of red zone behavior are clearly criminal, like rape and sexual assault.

The IRS is applied only to behavior that falls in the yellow zone. Resolution of these issues is simple. If the offender realizes he or she has behaved inappropriately, the best thing for them to do is address the issue before it is brought to their attention. This is taking responsibility for their actions. Often this does not happen though, because we do not recognize we have offended someone.

In that case, it becomes the responsibility of the person who was offended to bring it to the attention of the offender. This can be done in person, in writing, through a third person or through a supervisor. The key is that all people involved must take action. In other words, we all have a responsibility to stop unacceptable and inappropriate behavior.

What happens if the behavior does not stop or the behavior falls in the red zone? In these cases, there are no options, the matter must be forwarded through one of five formal methods, which include:

- Request Mast. This is the preferred method to file a complaint through the Commanding officer in the chain of command up to the individual's immediate commanding general.

- Article 138, UCMJ Complaint. This method alleges wrongs committed by the commanding officer.

- Redress of Wrongs Committed by a Superior. This is used if a complaint is filed against any other superior, in rank or command, who the service member believes committed

a wrongdoing.

- Communications with Inspectors Generals. This method is used as an alternative to the normal chain of command.

- Individual Communications with Congress. Personnel may write to members of Congress any time concerning EO issues. Personnel who feel they need to file a formal complaint should first ensure they have attempted to resolve it at the lowest level. If this is not possible, they should attempt resolution using the preferred method of Request Mast.

It is imperative behaviors of sexual harassment are identified, addressed and corrected immediately. Most of these issues can be resolved at the lowest level through informal resolution; however, if warranted, any person who is being sexually harassed must report it, preferably to their chain of command.

Black history means culture

Contrary to popular belief, Black History month is not only for blacks. The idea is to educate everyone on the history and culture of Black America. In an effort to provide some insight into my history, I would like to share the story of a black man who has motivated me by his accomplishments.

Jean Baptiste Pointe DuSable was a true pioneer, for he ventured into America's heartland where few whites and certainly no blacks had gone. He had a vision and a vigor that led to the creation of a community which grew into Chicago.

It is thought DuSable was born in 1745 in what is now Haiti, the son of a French mariner and an African-born slave woman. It is also possible, like other free people of color in his country, he was educated in Paris. After a shipwreck on a voyage to New Orleans around 1762, he found the city under Spanish rule and decided to make his way up the

Mississippi River and unknowingly, into history.

DuSable was a merchant, fur trader and farmer on the banks of what is now called the Chicago River. Around 1773, he built a trading post, which included a 40 x 22' building, a size unheard of in the wilderness. In a relatively short time, his business had grown to include a house, two barns, a mill, a dairy, a bake house, poultry house, workshop and a stable with a large holding of livestock.

In 1788 he married Catherine, a Potowami Indian. Shortly thereafter, he sold his property for an estimated \$1,200, a sizeable sum for the time. He is then reported to have moved to the St. Charles, Mo., area until his death in 1818. He never returned to Chicago.

To honor his contribution to their great city, in 1912, a plaque was placed on a building at the corner of Pine and Kinzie Streets in Chicago, at the site of the first house he erected. Without the pioneering spirit of DuSable and others like him, the heartland of America would not have been tamed.

In 1987, DuSable was honored on a stamp featured in the Black Heritage series. He and other noted blacks are spotlighted for their contributions and dedication to self-improvement.

Phone improvements begin

In December 1995, AT&T was awarded a service-wide contract for extensive base phone services, including in-room phone service in unaccompanied personnel housing.

As part of this phase of the project here, a site blessing was held Jan. 14 at building 503 in hopes of safe and timely work.

"We hope to have the first phase, about 23 buildings, in service on April 1," explained Robert T. Kawai, regional site manager, AT&T.

The remaining 42 buildings should be in-service by June with a little help from mother nature. "When it rains they have to stop

all the trenching. There's no problem if they're working inside — it's the outside work that is slowed down," he stressed.

Bell Atlantic Professional Services has been contracted to perform engineering and construction of the Navy Exchange Service Command project.

The present phase of the project will complete the installation of phones in each UPH room with additional services free of charge.

"They'll be getting voice mail at no extra charge, they'll have call forwarding at no extra charge — all of these features they would ordinarily have to pay for," Kawai said.

In conjunction with the start

of phone service, a Barracks Bash will be held in early April. The event is coordinated by the Single Marine Program and sponsored by AT&T.

The day-long event will feature a Battle of the Bands in which the winner will represent MCB Hawaii at the USO Battle of the Bands in June.

Additional events include a mud volleyball competition, 3-on-3 basketball, tug-of-war, and a golf clinic. Refreshments will also be available.

Following the completion of buildings here, the crew from AT&T and Bell Atlantic will go to Camp Smith, which is presently in the design phase of planning, then move onto other involved locations on Oahu.

Kunia honors colors at Hula Bowl

AIEA — Although their missions as Marines are classified, color guard Marines from I Company, Marine Support Battalion, Kunia Regional Signals Operations Center, don't hold back when it comes to flying their Marine Corps colors in front of a stadium full of people.

Iwo Marine visits K-Bay

Says spirit is same regardless of changes

Since the days before World War II, when Camp Maui was a base made up mostly of tents on the island of Maui, and a Marine's most trusted weapon was an M-1 Springfield, the Marine Corps' presence in Hawaii has transformed into a bigger, more technological force. When Herb A. Roberts, a 72-year-old former Marine with two Purple Hearts who was based at Camp Maui, visited here Jan. 16, his eyes lit up with amazement. The Corps as he knew it has changed into an entirely different organization according to him.

"It's amazing to see all of these weapons and young Marines," the Morton Grove, Ill., native said. "I can't believe how far the military has come in such a short time."

Recalling the battle he fought on Iwo Jima, Roberts said it was the first time he

had seen rockets used in battle. Now, rockets are old news while computerized weapons take the lead on the technological battlefield.

Though the Corps has advanced from bolt-action, single-shot rifles to machine guns that can fling lead several rounds per minute, according to Roberts, the Marines and the history remain the same.

Roberts enlisted out of Lane Tech High School in Chicago at 18. Following boot camp in 1943 at Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego, Calif., he was assigned to Headquarters and Service Company, 24th Marine Regiment, 4th Marine Division.

During his time in service, Roberts was combat wounded in Roi-Namur and Saipan. He also participated in the bloody battle for Iwo Jima, "but the only thing I got there was malaria," he said.

Toward the end of his time in service, Roberts faced a major decision. He wanted to

be a Marine and continue his career with a tour in China. However, a young lady back home was begging for wedding bells, he said.

"As God is my witness, there was only way I could solve it," said Roberts, pretending to pull a coin from his pocket. "Heads, I go home, tails, I go to Asia."

When the coin came to rest

on the back of his hand, the choice had been clear. He went home to a wife has been with her for 51 years.

But the Corps is far from gone from his life.

"Not a day goes by that I don't think about it," said Roberts. "Besides my wedding day, it was the best thing I've ever experienced to date."

"During the week leading up to the Super Bowl, we sell around \$100,000 worth of snacks and accessories," said Copenhefer. "With a variety of around 300 different items

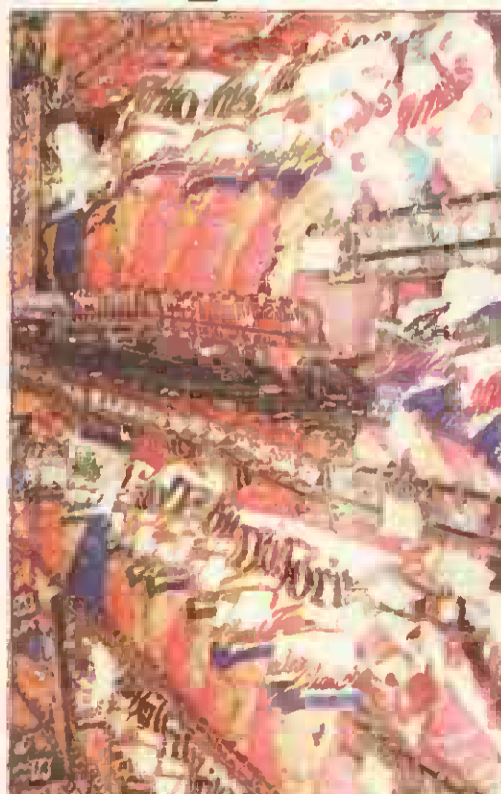
for snacks and parties, we have plenty to choose from."

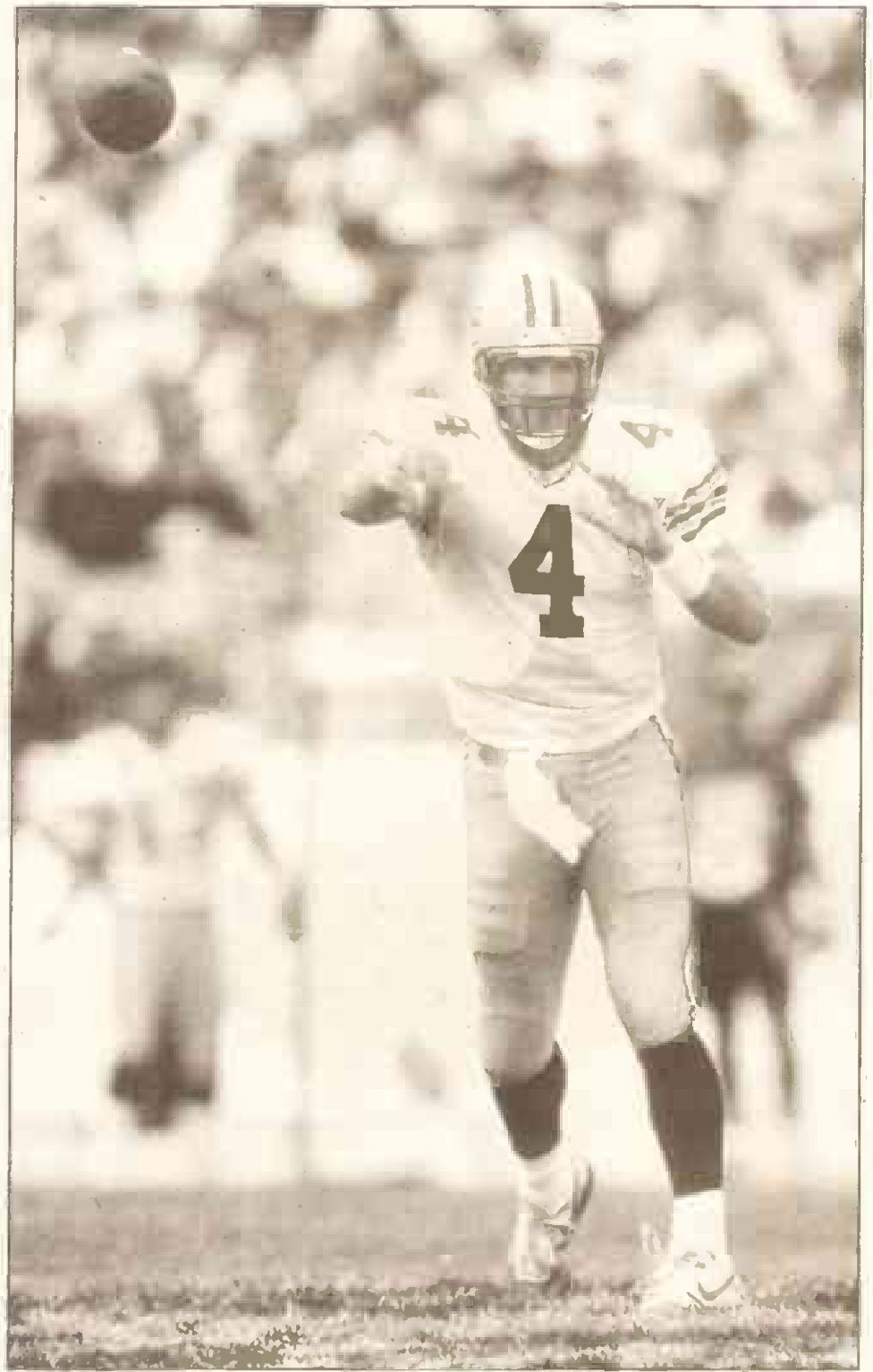
Bowl was decided in the bayou, the contest turned into a "Super Bore." In 1986, the Chicago Bears plowed the Patriots, 46-10. Four years later, San Francisco trounced Denver, 55-10.

Green Bay offense vs. New England defense

As in 1986, the Patriots appear to be fighting a hopeless battle against this season's darlings of destiny. But this New England team bears little resemblance to the "Patsies" of old simply because of one man: Bill Parcells.

Parcells has won two Super Bowls with the New York Giants in 1986 and 1991. His coaching philosophy is based on the formula that hard-nosed defense and ball-control offense wins football games. And given two weeks to prepare for a game, Parcells is without peer.

The task facing him and assistants Bill Belichick and Al Groh this week will be to ready the

troops in time to face one of the league's most explosive offenses in Green Bay. After suffering embarrassing back-to-back losses to Kansas City and Dallas at mid-season, coach Mike Holmgren's West Coast offense has ripped off seven straight

wins, outscoring opponents by an average score of 32-10.

The Packer attack is led by quarterback Brett Favre, the NFL's two-time MVP.

Favre has developed into a savvy leader and a master of improvisation since coming to Cheeseville. His physical ability has never been questioned, although his tendency to make poor decisions under pressure in the past kept him from rising to the level of the NFL elite. Now, he's arguably the league's finest signal-caller.

As impressive as Parcells is in preparing his defense to face any given offense, Favre is the key factor and the x-factor rolled into one

From page 3 — making him almost impossible to plan against.

But make no mistake: If Favre were the beginning and the end of the Green Bay offense, the Packers would have never escaped the frozen tundra.

Edgar Bennett and Dorsey Levens make up perhaps the most underrated backfield tandem in the league. Add to that mix tight ends Mark Chmura and Keith Jackson and receivers Antonio Freeman and Andre Rison, and you have the makings of a highly combustible offense.

The Patriots aren't loaded with Pro Bowl-caliber players on defense, but they're an opportunistic bunch that knows how to win. In fact, they haven't

allowed a touchdown in their last 10 quarters. So if the Pats are to bring the trophy home to their title-starved fans, the defense will have to do the driving.

New England's no-name defensive front, which includes first-round graduate Willie McGinest, must control the line of scrimmage, put pressure on Favre and contain him when he leaves the pocket.

Mission impossible? Maybe not.

The Patriot proved to be up to the challenge against Brunell in the AFC championship game when they stuffed Natrone Means and bottled up a speedy quarterback in Mark Brunell.

A key to New England's success could be the play of rookie

linebacker Tedy Bruschi. Bruschi shadowed Brunell's every move in in the AFC championship game and wound up disrupting Jacksonville's attack. While the Patriot secondary must play fly-paper coverage on Green Bay's crafty receivers, it may be up to Bruschi to keep Favre from turning broken plays into big gains.

And as polished as Favre has become, he still has a tendency to get rattled in big game situations. If the Patriots can put pressure on him early and keep it on, they'll have a chance to pull off the upset. If they allow Favre to get into a groove, the Patriots may need another power outage to save them.

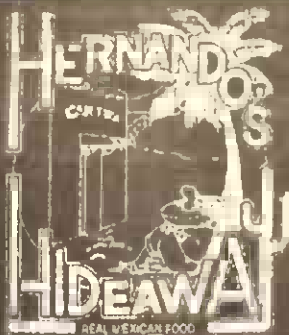

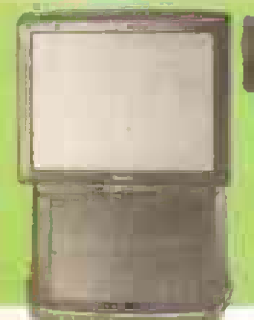

New England Offense vs. Green Bay Defense

The Patriots used the No. 1 pick in the 1993 draft to select quarterback Drew Bledsoe, with the intention that he would one day lead them to the promised land.

Four years and

some severe growing pains later, Bledsoe has delivered.

The strong-armed quarterback has matured into a Pro Bowl-caliber signal-caller and a highly competent field leader. But he'll be looking into the teeth of a fierce Green Bay defense the moment he steps on the Superdome's plastic

grass.

Bledsoe remains the centerpiece of the New England offense, but Parcels may not want to put the entire weight of the game plan on his young quarterback's shoulders. As in Super Bowl XXV, look for Parcels to try to shorten the game by running the ball at the Packer

defense and using the short passing game.

Here's a stat to keep an eye on: the number of times running back Curtis Martin touches the ball. If Martin is established as a threat from the get-go, the Packer defense will be forced to contain the

line of scrimmage, thus opening gaps in the secondary for receiver Terry Glenn and tight end Ben Coates. Fullback Keith Byars may be the thorn in Green Bay's side, simply because Byars is a threat both on the ground and as a pass catcher out of the backfield.

If Martin can pick up first downs and keep Favre and company on the bench, the Patriots will be in business. But if New England falls behind and Bledsoe is forced to throw on every down, the Patriots could be looking at another Super Bowl disaster.

Leading the charge against Bledsoe will be the Packers' incomparable Reggie White. The Minister of Defense is on a mission to add a

Super Bowl ring to his already vast collection of honors, and he's taking the rest of the Packer defense with him.

How tough is Green Bay's defense? Well, the Packers held opponents to single-digit scoring six times this season!

Defensive end Sean Jones and tackles Santana Dotson and Gilbert Brown have joined White as one

of the best units in the league. The linebacking corps may be without leading tackler George Koonce, but Ron Cox is an experienced replacement.

Outside linebackers Wayne Simmons and Brian Williams aren't the most well-known pair, but they get the job done.

The secondary, led by safeties LeRoy
